Acting Course Level 1

3 Month Acting Course: Season 1 2025 Itinerary

The course takes place over 3 months, with 9 sessions focusing on professional development. We work on developing your acting skills, your confidence, USP and industry behaviour to make that first impression count.

Outcomes:

- Understand and be able to make strong acting choices
- Analyse and critically reflect on your own performances and performances of others.
- Cover various techniques to implement into your preparation for a role or audition.
- Know how to approach an audition, network and stand out.
- A clear progress report and a personal acting development plan.

Workshop 1: 8th January 2025 6:00pm – 9:00pm

- Induction
- Warm-up games (getting to know each other, making connections as actors)
- Improvisation – working on improvisation, in particular improvisation for auditions.

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Workshop 2: 15th January 2025 6:00pm – 9:00pm

- Cold reading scripts & taking direction
- Scripts handed out and actors work on a cold read. This occurs regularly at auditions).
- From this first cold read, direction will be given and actors will be tested on how this is applied to their scene. (Actors must be able to take direction, must be malleable, adaptable and open. This is often tested by a casting director in an audition to determine how an actor will work on set and under pressure).
- Perform and review scene at the end of the workshop to class.

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Workshop 3: 22nd January 2025 6:00pm – 9:00pm

- Audition technique
- Hot seating – being able to answer audition questions about your scene and yourself on the spot.
- Audition practice – going through the various scenarios of an audition
- Actors come in with last workshop scene and audition on camera.
- Review of all performances.

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Workshop 4: 29th January 2025 6:00pm – 9:00pm

- Working on scenes and character objectives.
- Working on back-story, not relying on the script as many actors do, thus forgetting the basics of the scene. We will strip the scene apart and work on all aspects of this, touching upon Stanislavski's Character objectives.

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Workshop 5: 5th February 2025 6:00pm – 9:00pm

- Performing scenes/scenarios on camera

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Workshop 6: 12th February 2025 6:00pm – 9:00pm

- Introduction to Meisner technique
- Learning vocal technique looking at diaphragmatic breathing, warm up voice and
- Vocal exercises.

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Workshop 7: 26th February 2025 6:00pm – 9:00pm

- Self-tape!
- Learn how to frame, shoot, deliver a slate and your scene to camera!
- **THIS IS SO IMPORTANT:** We will teach you how to deliver a strong self-tape audition.

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Workshop 8: 5th March 2025 6:00pm – 9:00pm

- Mock showcase
- New scenes, actors paired up and left to work on the scenes implementing all that was covered in the course. With assistance from one of the Coaches
